
RESOLUTION NO. 21216

Background

The Illinois State Toll Highway Authority (the "Tollway") is interested in procuring Underground Fuel Storage Tank Monitoring System Services. Pursuant to the Tollway's Invitation for Bid No. 16-0069R, the Tollway has determined that Stenstrom Petroleum Services, Inc. (d.b.a. Stenstrom Petroleum Services Group) is the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for Underground Fuel Storage Tank Monitoring System Services for an upper limit of compensation not to exceed \$127,760.00.

Resolution

The bid from Stenstrom Petroleum Services, Inc. (d.b.a. Stenstrom Petroleum Services Group) for the purchase of Underground Fuel Storage Tank Monitoring System Services is accepted. Contract No. 16-0069R is approved in an amount not to exceed \$127,760.00. 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1. DESCRIPTION OF SUPPLIES AND SERVICES

- 1.1. GOAL: The Illinois Tollway is dedicated to providing and promoting a safe and efficient system of toll supported highways while ensuring the highest possible level of service to our customers. The Illinois Tollway is looking for vendors who share that commitment and will help meet that goal.
- 1.2. SUPPLIES AND/OR SERVICES REQUIRED: The Illinois Tollway is seeking a vendor to provide repairs and emergency call out services to include, but not be limited to: repairs, monitoring, testing, and emergency response services for its underground fuel storage tank monitoring system services (TLS 350 Veeder Root Systems), including the repair of sensors and parts that keep the fuel systems functioning, on an as-needed basis at various locations throughout the Tollway system.

Due to geographical size, this contract is separated into two (2) zones: Group 1: East Zone and Group 2: West Zone. Bidders are not required to bid on both zones to be considered responsive, but shall bid on all items within a zone. Bidders may bid on one (1) or both zones. The estimated quantities of this contract shall be based on a period of three (3) years; prices shall remain firm for the term of the contract.

- 1.2.1 Hourly Rates (Groups 1a and 2a): The awarded contract shall be a time and materials contract. Regular hourly rates shall include the period from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. CDT, Monday through Friday. Emergency hourly rates shall include all other hours not defined above, including overnight, weekend, and holiday hours. Emergency rates shall be invoiced at one and one-half times the hourly rate. Rates begin at the time the Vendor arrives at the Illinois Tollway's worksite and ends when the Vendor departs from the Illinois Tollway's work-site.
 - 1.2.1.1 Emergency Call Out Service: In an emergency where fueling operations are shut down due to a failure of the tank monitoring system, the Vendor's response time to the affected location shall be within three (3) hours of the fax or email request for service call from Tollway personnel. Emergency response for repairs that are not affecting fueling operations, but have active alarms shall be within four (4) hours of the service call from Tollway personnel. All other types of repairs shall be responded to within twenty-four (24) hours of the service request.

Vendor shall supply the Illinois Tollway with a single twenty-four (24) hour, seven (7) day per week contact phone number. This number shall be manned at all times. If a message service is used by the vendor to receive off-hour emergency calls, a return call from the Vendor's service personnel shall be made to the Tollway within 15 minutes. If the vendor's contact number changes for any reason, the Tollway shall be notified ten (10) working days prior to the change.

Only Tollway designated personnel will be authorized to contact the Vendor for any type of service calls or repairs to Tollway property. Any unauthorized services will not be paid for by the Tollway.

For proper Fire Marshall Record keeping requirement, a detailed description of the repairs shall be furnished to the Tollway personnel at the repair location, and also sent

to the Illinois Tollway's Facilities Services Manager, Mike LoPresti at mlopresti@getipass.com before the Technician leaves the site.

1.2.1.2 Repairs and Services: If in the course of the emergency call out service the Vendor determines that any fuel tank monitoring system requires repair or replacement parts, the Vendor shall submit an itemized quotation to the Illinois Tollway Facility Services Manager and no further work shall proceed until authorized. Vendor's quotation shall detail the repairs to be completed, the cost of such repairs and/or replacement parts, and an anticipated completion date of the repair. All unrepairable components shall be returned to the Illinois Tollway.

In the event the Vendor shall order replacement parts, the Vendor shall notify the Tollway of the expected delivery of the parts and completion of the repairs. The Vendor is expected to initiate and complete all repairs as quickly as possible. If the Vendor expects a delay in repairing a unit, the Vendor shall communicate with the Tollway's Facilities Services Manager immediately.

1.2.2 Catalog / Percent Discount (Groups 1b and 2b): The percent discount bid in Groups 1b and 2b Catalog Pricing shall remain in effect for the entire term of the contract and any subsequent renewals. The successful bidder shall supply the Tollway with two (2) Manufacturer's Parts Price Lists within seven (7) business days after the notification of award. Copies shall be current and effective as of the contract start date. In the event the catalog is not available in paper format, the Vendor may provide this information in CD-ROM form compatible with any current Windows platform or a website accessible by Tollway personnel. During the initial term of the Contract and any subsequent renewals, the Tollway shall accept supplements to the manufacturer's list price catalog. It shall remain the sole responsibility of the Vendor to provide price supplements to the Tollway. These prices shall be effective as of the date the price supplements are received by the Tollway's Purchasing Department and shall be applied only to subsequent orders placed by the Tollway and not to pending orders already placed but not received by the Tollway. - 1.2.3 Quantities: It shall be expressly understood by the bidder that the estimated bid quantities specified in the contract documents are for the purpose of determining the lowest bid and to establish unit prices. The Tollway may, over the term of the Contract, place orders for more or fewer than the estimated quantities stated. The Tollway does not guarantee that any minimum number of quantities shall be ordered from the Vendor. The estimated quantities of this contract shall be based on a period of three (3) years; prices shall remain firm for the term of the contract. The decision to pre-order and hold any repair parts inventory rests solely with the Vendor.
- 1.2.4 <u>Related Performance Standards:</u> All material used shall match existing materials identified above or as found. All equipment, materials, and installation work shall comply with the above specifications, the Illinois Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) standards and relevant Illinois Building Codes.

- 1.2.5 <u>Standards of Performance</u>: The Vendor shall perform, or cause to be performed, all Work required of it under the terms and conditions of the Contract with that degree of skill, care and diligence normally exercised by an experienced vendor performing work in projects of a scope and magnitude comparable to this project. The Vendor shall use reasonable efforts to assure timely and satisfactory completion of the work. The Vendor shall at all times act in the best interest of the Tollway. The Vendor shall perform or cause to be performed, all work in accordance with the terms and conditions of this Contract and to the reasonable satisfaction of the Tollway.
- 1.2.6 Safety: The Vendor and its subcontractors shall perform the services in a safe and responsible manner. In the performance of the scope of work, the vendor shall shield all interior areas near the work area as required to protect Tollway personnel and property. Vendor shall at their own expense, conform to safety policies and regulations and comply with all specific safety requirements of the Occupational Safety and Health Act (OSHA) of 1970 and the Construction Safety Act of 1969 and all other related Acts.
- 1.2.7 Protection of Property: The Vendor shall conduct the work so as not to interfere with or hinder the daily activity within or around the designated work area that is established by the Tollway. If in the event, any damages (replacement, repairs) to existing property occur, the Vendor and/or its subcontractor shall be solely responsible for any expenses. Any scope of work that could impact personnel and/or property inside the building shall be scheduled and performed during off peak hours. Building operating personnel shall be consulted whenever fuel tank monitoring conditions might be affected. Peak hours are considered Monday through Friday, 8:00 am to 4:00 pm.
- 1.2.8 <u>Clean Up:</u> The Vendor shall, during the process of the work, remove and dispose of all materials and debris and keep the work site and adjacent premises in a clean condition satisfactory to the Tollway. Upon completion of work, the Vendor shall remove all materials, tools and machinery and restore the site to the same condition that existed prior to the commencement of its operation.
- 1.3. MILESTONES AND DELIVERABLES: Vendor shall submit itemized invoices within fifteen (15) days of each emergency call out service and/or repair at the Tollway. Invoices shall be marked to the attention of the Contract Invoice Administrator and delivered to the Illinois Tollway, P.O. Box 3094, in Lisle, IL 60532.
- 1.4. VENDOR / STAFF SPECIFICATIONS: The Vendor shall be authorized and licensed to perform the types of repairs or service to the Veeder Root underground fuel storage tank monitoring system outlined in this contract. Vendor shall provide a manufacturer's letter of authorization upon request of the Tollway, as proof of being an authorized service provider. Further, the Vendor shall be capable of furnishing original product warranty and manufacturer's related services such as product information, product recall notices, etc. The Vendor shall maintain an adequate stock of repair parts for the TLS 350 Veeder Root System. The Vendor shall provide all necessary equipment to gain access to the underground fuel storage tank monitoring systems at each location. The Vendor is prohibited from storing their equipment on Tollway property.

1.5. TRANSPORTATION AND DELIVERY: All travel time for repairs and services shall be included in the hourly rate. The Vendor shall be compensated for travel time to the Illinois Tollway location for one (1) vehicle only. In order to be compensated, this information shall be reflected separately on the Vendor invoice. Travel time shall be paid according to the Regular Hourly Rates as provided in Section 2, Pricing. The above shall apply, in all cases, on any type of service call.

1.6. SUBCONTRACTING:

If at any time during the term of the Contract, Vendor adds or changes any subcontractors, Vendor is required to promptly notify, in writing, the State Purchasing Officer or the Chief Procurement Officer of the names and addresses and the expected amount of money that each new or replaced subcontractor will receive pursuant to this Contract. Any subcontracts entered into prior to award of this Contract are done at the sole risk of the Vendor and subcontractor(s).

1.7. WHERE SERVICES ARE TO BE PERFORMED: Unless otherwise disclosed in this section all services shall be performed in the United States. If the Vendor performs the services purchased hereunder in another country in violation of this provision, such action may be deemed by the State as a breach of the contract by Vendor.

Vendor shall disclose the locations where the services required shall be performed and the known or anticipated value of the services to be performed at each location. If the Vendor received additional consideration in the evaluation based on work being performed in the United States, it shall be a breach of contract if the Vendor shifts any such work outside the United States.

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2.6 MAXIMUM AMOUNT: The total payments under this contract shall not exceed \$153,312.00 without a formal amendment. The maximum amount will be entered by the State prior to execution of the contract.

3. TERM AND TERMINATION

- **3.1 TERM OF THIS CONTRACT:** This contract has an initial term of three (3) years, anticipated as April 1, 2017 to March 31, 2020. If a start date is not identified, the term shall commence upon the last dated signature of the Parties.
 - 3.1.1 In no event will the total term of the contract, including the initial term, any renewal terms and any extensions, exceed ten (10) years.
 - 3.1.2 Vendor shall not commence billable work in furtherance of the contract prior to final execution of the contract except when permitted pursuant to 30 ILCS 500/20-80.

3.2 RENEWAL:

- 3.2.1. Any renewal is subject to the same terms and conditions as the original contract unless otherwise provided in the pricing section. The State may renew this contract for any or all of the option periods specified, may exercise any of the renewal options early, and may exercise more than one option at a time based on continuing need and favorable market conditions, when in the best interest of the State. The contract may neither renew automatically nor renew solely at the Vendor's option.
- 3.2.2. Pricing for the renewal term(s), or the formula for determining price, is shown in the pricing section of this contract.
- 3.2.3. The State reserves the right to renew for a total of two (2) years in any one of the following manners:
 - 3.2.3.1 One renewal covering the entire renewal allowance;
 - 3.2.3.2 Individual one-year renewals up to and including the entire renewal allowance; or
 - 3.2.3.3 Any combination of full or partial year renewals up to and including the entire renewal allowance.
- 3.3 TERMINATION FOR CAUSE: The State may terminate this contract, in whole or in part, immediately upon notice to the Vendor if: (a) the State determines that the actions or inactions of the Vendor, its agents, employees or subcontractors have caused, or reasonably could cause, jeopardy to health, safety, or property, or (b) the Vendor has notified the State that it is unable or unwilling to perform the contract.

If Vendor fails to perform to the State's satisfaction any material requirement of this contract, is in violation of a material provision of this contract, or the State determines that the Vendor lacks the financial resources to perform the contract, the State shall provide written notice to the Vendor to cure the problem identified within the period of time specified in the State's written notice. If not cured by that date the State may either: (a) immediately terminate the contract without additional written notice or (b) enforce the terms and conditions of the contract.
