Contract #: N/A**Description:** A Third Addendum Intergovernmental Agreement (“IGA”) with the University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign (“University”)**Scope:** In order to protect and preserve federal and state endangered or threatened species, the Tollway is required to comply with various environmental regulations as well as conditions included in permits issued by federal and state agencies, including the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service, United States Army Corps of Engineers, Illinois Department of Natural Resources and Illinois Environmental Protection Agency. To comply with such regulations and permits requirements, the Tollway must evaluate all of its projects and often is required to monitor and evaluate conditions at its project site long after completing construction. Also, to ensure that issues relating to endangered or threatened species can be taken into account when planning potential future Tollway projects, the Tollway conducts programmatic environmental evaluations across its system in advance of such projects.

The Illinois Natural History Survey (“INHS”), which is based out of the University of Illinois, is the State’s primary natural resource research and survey authority. In 2015, the Tollway partnered with INHS to conduct evaluations regarding endangered or threatened species on Tollway projects. The Tollway and the University wish to continue their partnership by extending the current December 31, 2021 termination date of the existing IGA to December 31, 2026. During the extended period, Mitigation Bank Monitoring, Development of Next Generation Survey Methods Using E-DNA, a Mussel Survival Study at the I-90 Kishwaukee River Bridge and other ongoing surveys and assessments will continue, and Proactive Surveys for Endangered, Threatened and Rare Species, Targeted Rusty Patch Bumble Bee Surveys, Targeted Potential Bat Roost Tree Surveys, and Biotic Stream Assessments will be initiated.

Amending the existing IGA prior to its December 31, 2021 termination date, rather than entering into a new agreement, will result in significant savings to the Tollway because the University will continue to apply the 10% the Facilities and Administrative (“F&A”) rate included in the existing IGA as opposed to the 20% rate that would apply if the parties entered into a new agreement.

Amount: Third Addendum IGA cost: The estimated cost to the Tollway is \$6,226,400.
