



## Record of Meeting | July 22, 2021

The Illinois State Toll Highway Authority's ("Tollway") Board of Directors met in regular session on Thursday, July 22, 2021. The meeting was held pursuant to the By-Laws of the Tollway upon call and notice of the meeting executed by Chairman Willard S. Evans, Jr. and posted in accordance with the requirements of the Open Meetings Act, 5 ILCS 120/1, *et seq.*

Due to necessary precautions relating to COVID-19, in accordance with the Gubernatorial Disaster Proclamation and current conditions, and consistent with the Open Meetings Act, it was determined by Chairman Willard S. Evans, Jr. that an in-person meeting of the body was neither practical nor prudent. In compliance with all conditions of Section 7(e) of the Open Meetings Act, 5 ILCS 120/7(e), the Board of Directors meeting was conducted by audio conference. A telephone access number was provided for members of the public to monitor and/or participate in the meeting.

The Board Secretary declared a quorum present.



Chairman Evans reported that the annual Lt. Rich Kozik Heritage Motorcycle Run, a fundraiser for the Illinois State Police Memorial Park recognizing those who have given their lives in the line of duty, began at Tollway Headquarters on July 17, 2021. He highlighted that over 300 participating riders from across the State joined in the ride to Springfield to attend memorial events honoring the brave men and women of the Illinois State Police.

Chairman Evans then introduced Captain Jason Bradley, Illinois State Police District 15, to provide a safety message.

### **Safety Message**

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Captain Jason Bradley emphasized the dangers of distracted driving and stated that Illinois State Police are using proactive enforcement patrols and media campaigns to educate the public.

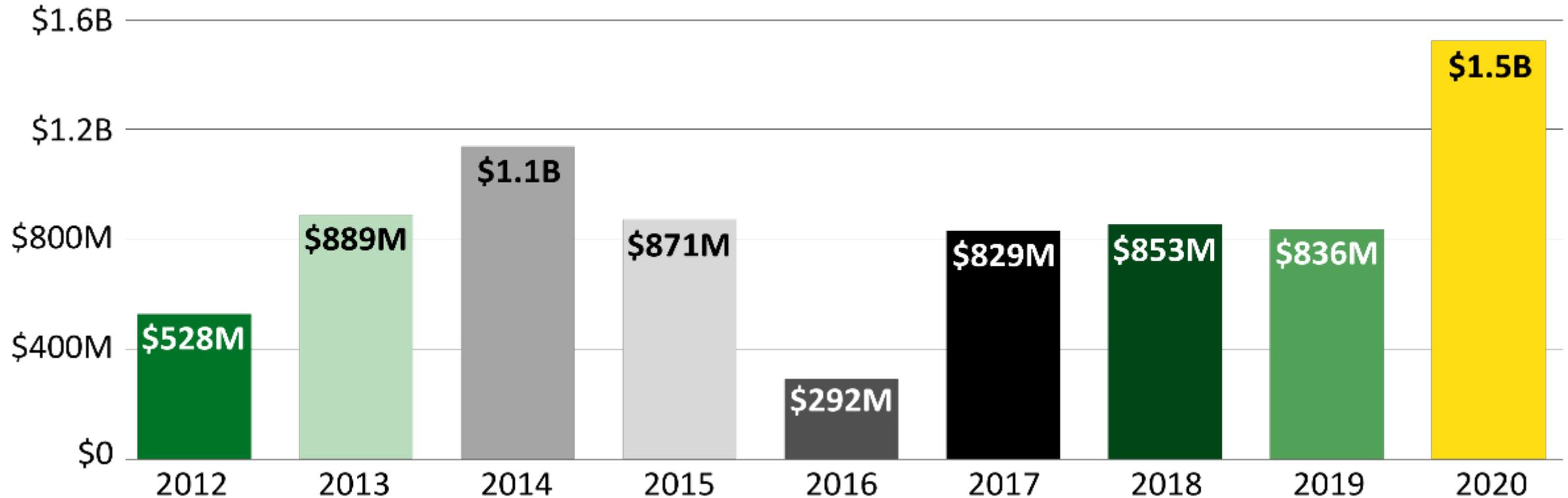

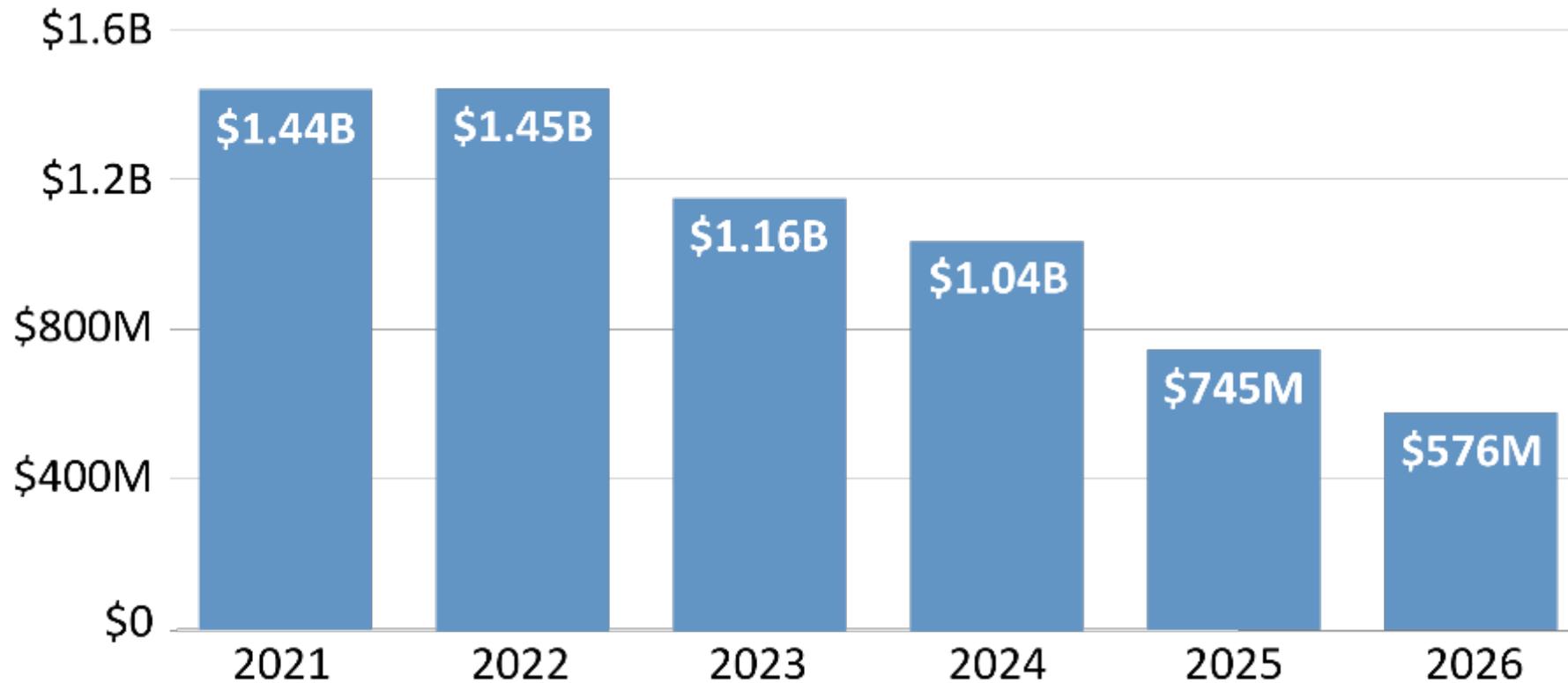

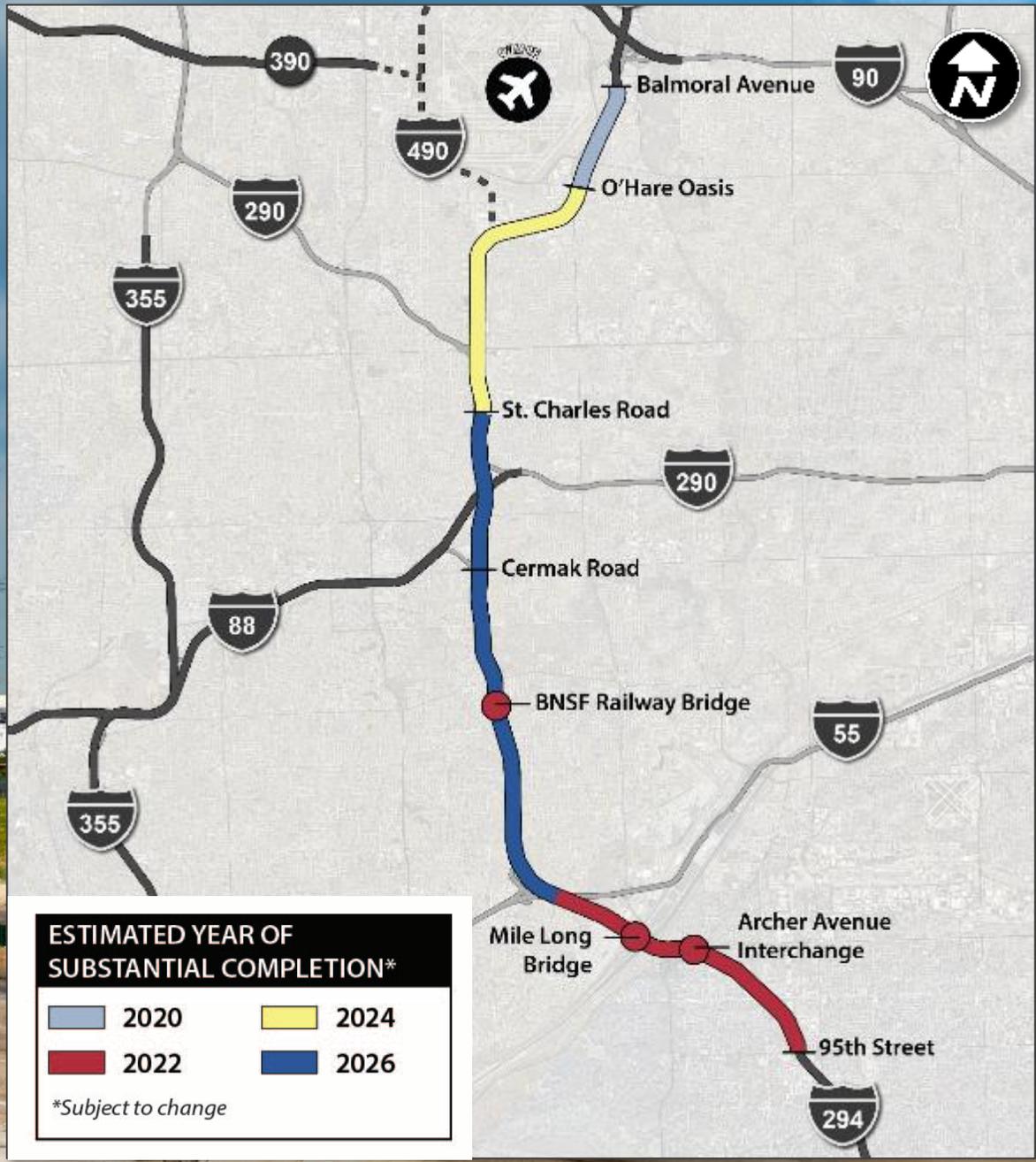

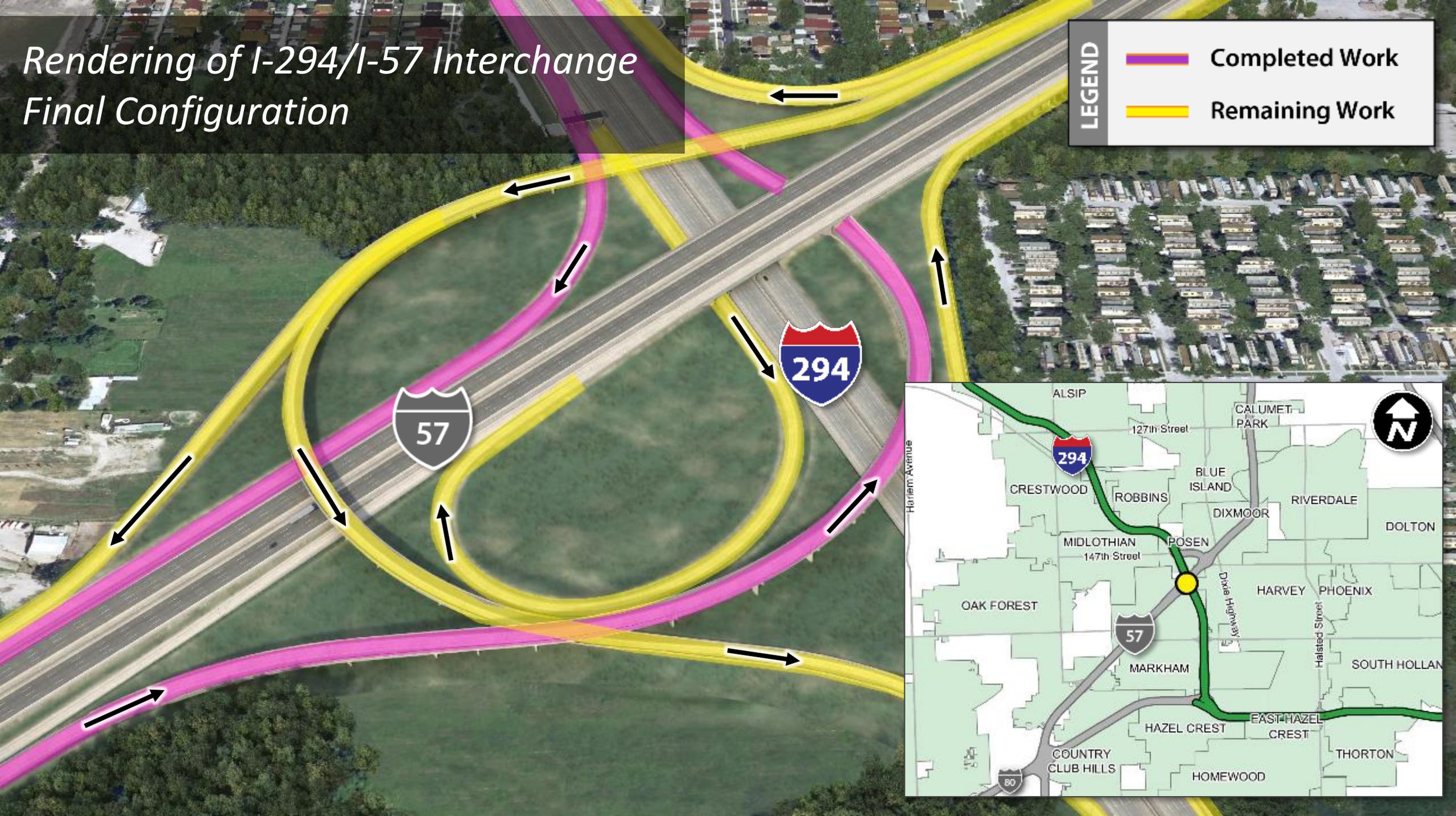

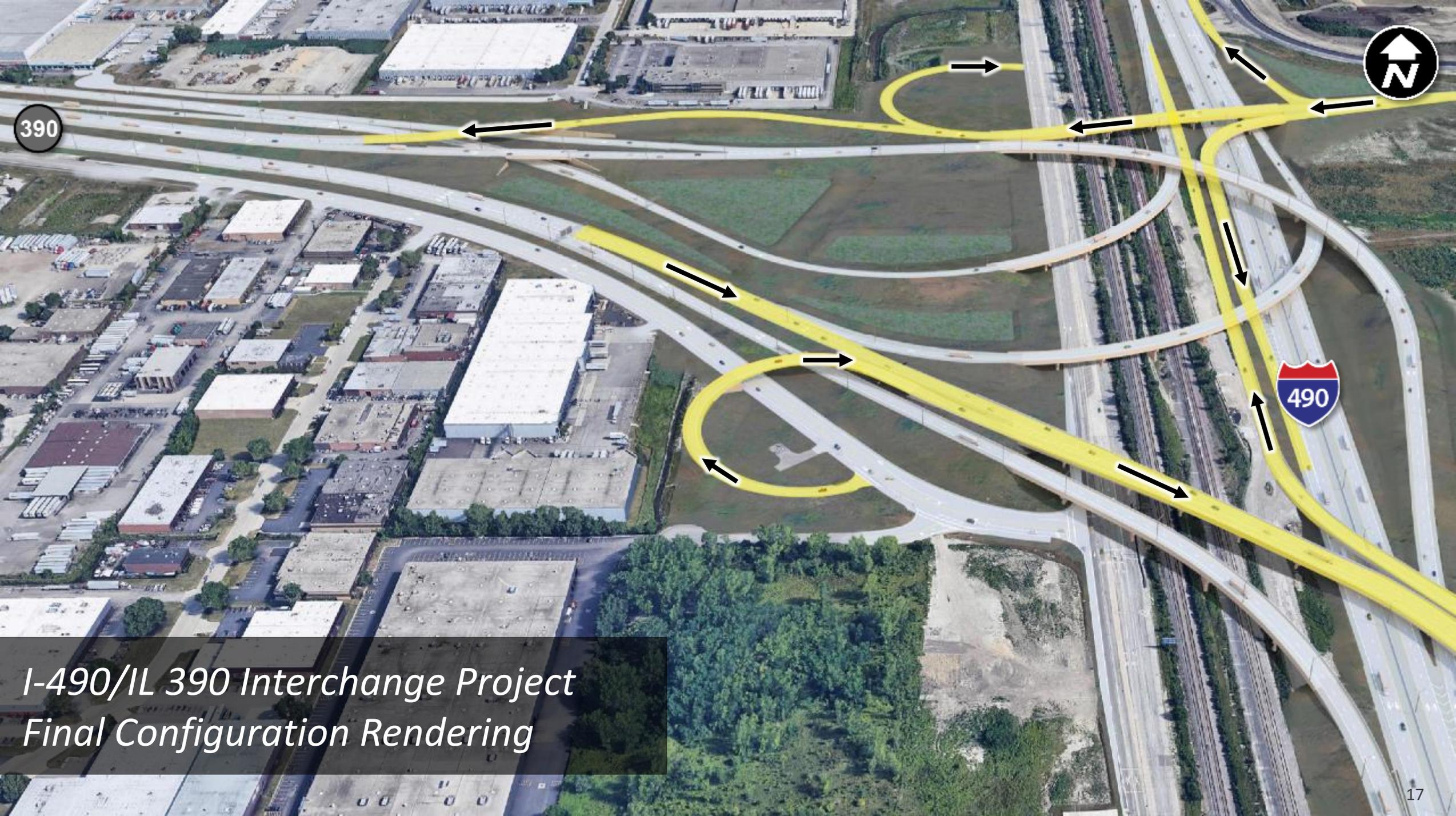
