Description: Rolling Owner-Controlled Insurance Program (ROCIP)

Scope: The Finance Department recommends acceptance of a proposal for ROCIP – an owner-provided insurance program which is an ongoing, or rolling wrap-up insurance program. ROCIP insures ongoing construction programs covering multiple projects. Projects are rolled into and out of the program as they are started and completed. The date projects are removed from the program can vary, but most provide an extended period of completed operations coverage. The coverage will be General Liability only and will allow smaller businesses to bid without having to procure the insurance limits when required on Tollway solicitations, thus allowing these smaller businesses to remove any cost of insurance from their bid proposal.
