Background

The Illinois State Toll Highway Authority (the "Tollway" or "Authority"), pursuant to the Toll Highway Act, 605 ILCS 10/1 et seq. (the "Act"), is granted all powers necessary to carry out its legislative purposes as to the construction, operation, regulation and maintenance of its system of toll highways.

On August 25, 2011 the Tollway adopted Resolution No. 19480 approving a \$12.1 billion long range plan for the Tollway System known as "Move Illinois: The Illinois Tollway Driving the Future" (as approved, the "Move Illinois Program"). The Move Illinois Program provides for various capital projects throughout the Tollway System.

On October 7, 2011, the Governor approved preliminary plans and cost estimates relating to the capital improvements in the Move Illinois Program.

Paragraph 5 of Section 511 of the Tollway's Amended and Restated Trust Indenture Effective March 31, 1999 (the "Master Indenture") authorizes the Authority to adopt resolutions pursuant to cost estimates of proposed Improvements prepared by the Authority's Consulting Engineer which resolutions may provide for the establishment in the Improvement Account of amounts for such specified Improvements.

The Consulting Engineer (as defined in the Master Indenture) has reviewed cost estimates of the Move Illinois Program and provided such reviewed cost estimates to the Tollway. Such cost estimates total \$12.1 billion, of which \$6.4 billion are anticipated to be Improvements.

Resolution

A capital improvement requirement of \$1 billion is established within the Improvement Account for the funding of a portion of the Improvements of the Move Illinois Program. The Chief of Finance is authorized to cause to be deposited to the Improvement Account for the funding of such portion of Improvements of the Move Illinois Program an amount not to exceed \$1billion, less any amount of such portion of Improvements of the Move Illinois Program funded by pre-existing balances in the

Improvement Account. The authorization to deposit funds to the Improvement Account is subject to a certification or certifications of cost estimates from the Consulting Engineer.

Background

It is necessary and in the best interest of the Illinois State Toll Highway Authority ("Tollway") to obtain and continue to accept credit card and other types of payment for its I-Pass, violation and other programs. Pursuant to the Illinois Procurement Code, the Illinois Tollway issued a Request for Proposals in 2007 (RFP# 07-0110) for merchant card services, and pursuant to Resolution No. 17884, dated September 27, 2007, authorized Fifth Third Bank (now Vantiv) to perform transactions for the initial term of three years, January 1, 2008, through December 31, 2010, with two one-year renewal options through December 31, 2012. Pursuant to Resolution No. 19257, this contract was renewed for a one year period commencing January 1, 2011, through December 31, 2011.

Section 1.2025 of the Department of Central Management Services procurement rules provides that bidding is not required where the procurement is available from only one economically feasible source. American Express and Discover Card were determined to be sole source providers, and pursuant to Resolution No. 17884, dated September 27, 2007, agreements were entered into with American Express and Discover Card for the initial terms of three years, January 1, 2008, through December 31, 2010, with two one-year renewal options through December 31, 2012. Pursuant to Resolution No. 19257, these contracts were renewed for a one year period commencing January 1, 2011, through December 31, 2011.

Resolution No. 17884 established an initial upper limit of compensation for all three contracts at \$36,000,000. Resolution No. 19257 increased this upper limit to \$48,800,000 to fund the renewals.

In 2011, a Request for Proposals was issued for merchant card processing. Pursuant to Resolution No. 19400, the Tollway Board awarded a contract to Fifth Third Processing Solutions, LLC (now Vantiv) for a period of three years with two one-year renewal options. Under this contract, Vantiv will also process Discover cards, with Discover's permission. Thus, a sole source contract with Discover did not need to be pursued.

In addition, the Tollway submitted a Procurement Business Case to obtain approval to award a two year sole source contract for merchant card processing to

American Express. At this time, approvals are still pending for the Vantiv and American Express contracts.

Resolution

Therefore, to avoid an interruption in the processing of merchant cards, it is necessary and in the best interest of the Tollway to extend the contracts with Vantiv, American Express, and Discover for a period of 90 days, commencing January 1, 2012, through March 30, 2012, and to increase the upper limit of compensation by \$5,500,000 for these three contracts from \$48,800,000 to \$54,300,000.

The Acting General Counsel and the Chief of Finance are authorized to negotiate the aforementioned merchant card agreement extensions, the Chair and Executive Director are authorized to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate said agreements, and the Chief of Finance is authorized to issue warrants in payment thereof.

Background

It is necessary and desirable for The Illinois State Toll Highway Authority ("Tollway") to retain certain financial advisory firms to assist the Tollway in connection with existing capital debt, new bond issues, and other financing initiatives.

Per the RFP, "the Tollway reserves the right to extend the term of the contract for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days."

As of the date of this resolution, the Financial Advisors have received \$481,259 in compensation under the Agreements. The collective remaining capacity of the Agreements is \$118,741. The Tollway's need for financial advisory services for the 90day period January 1, 2012 - March 30, 2012 is expected to be within the remaining capacity of the Agreements.

Resolution

The expiration date of each of the Agreements is hereby revised from December 31, 2011 to March 30, 2012. The Chair and the Executive Director are authorized to execute any and all documents, subject to review and approval of the Acting General Counsel, necessary to effectuate a ninety-day extension for the period January 1, 2012 -March 30, 2012.
